



Youth Artist Development Scholarship

Person2Person Scholarship Program is intended to provide outstanding young artists with assistance to further their artistic development. Our ability to provide financial support comes from funds raised at events throughout the year as well as from individual donations. We encourage all families who believe in their children and their ability to succeed to apply!

Our scholarships are need-based & merit-based. Eligibility is determined through a review of the applicant's submission requirements, as well as income documentation (for need-based scholarships only). Awarded amounts vary depending upon the length and cost of the customized program and the family's income level. A P2P scholarship may cover all or a portion of the tuition cost for a recipient depending on available funds during the award period. Priority is given to P2P Y.A.D.A. and Camp PS150 students, however, when there is an excess of funds available, Person2Person Management may award a one-time scholarship to youth in an existing local arts program.

HOW TO APPLY:

1. Contact us via email (scholarship@person2personmanagement.com) to indicate your interest in applying. In your initial email include: child's name, parent or legal guardian, current email address, and contact phone numbers.
2. Submit two letters of recommendation from a community leader such as teacher, clergyman, or professional performing artist.
3. Complete scholarship requirements below:

Scholarship Requirements:

First round applicants must submit a 2-minute long audition video demonstrating their abilities and proficiency level. Include a brief introduction followed by a rendition of your best song, dance, or monologue. The introduction should include your full name, age, hometown, school, your favorite hobbies, and why you want to be a performing artist or media spokesperson.

Second Round

Write an essay on any one of the following topics:

- a. Who do you believe are the biggest influences in the Performing Arts and Entertainment industry today and why?
- b. What are your dreams, aspirations, and goals and how do you intend to reach them?
- c. What do you think is the future of the media; include how it relates to social media growth, trends, and how people receive information today?

Essay Length: 2-5 paragraphs for ages 7yrs-12yrs and 250 words or more for ages 13-17
